

The Solution

Grand & Toy carefully considered NCFST's business, layout and space restrictions and proposed a striking and collaborative design concept. Global Bouleuvard workstations were installed along with Diet panels to optimize floor space while providing sufficient privacy. Stylish filing cabinets in shades of blue, red and green were positioned under desks and along the walls to add splashes of colour.

- Inventive Earth and sky hues differentiate departments and coordinate with the textured animal graphics etched on windows and doors
- **Bright** Lower height panels give an open look and allow for a natural flow of light
- Resourceful Furnishings were selected and adjusted to meet the leveling challenge of a concrete, uneven floor, while cabling and electrical wires were expertly weaved through the floor and up to the workstations
