Our records indicate that previously you purchased a Lenovo M90z ThinkCentre all-in-one Desktop Computer (Product code 3429) from Grand and Toy. Grand and Toy recently received a notice from Lenovo advising the company of a voluntary product recall for Lenovo M90z Think Centre all-in-one Desktop Computer.

Lenovo has determined that due to a failure of the power supply in the Lenovo M90z ThinkCentre all-in-one Desktop Computer the system can overheat posing a fire hazard. Lenovo recommends that you should immediately stop using the affected desktop PC, and unplug the power cord..

Note: Lenovo considers the defect to pose a potential safety hazard

Effective immediately, Lenovo is offering free power-supply replacements for all affected ThinkCentre M90z and ThinkCentre M70z all-in-one desktop PCs. To determine whether your ThinkCentre M90z all-in-one desktop PC is affected by the recall visit http://support.lenovo.com/en_US/detail.page?DocID=HT071924 to check by unit's serial number. Lenovo recommends customers should immediately stop using the computer and unplug it from the outlet.
